<p>8.1 Field experiences must provide at least 300 hours of observation, teaming, professional responsibilities, duties, and/or activities in authentic settings: information on the total of expected hours of field experience, description of activities other than supervised interpreting and total of clock hours engaged in each activity, length or time span of the field experiences, and application of learned principles.</p>																		
<p>8.2 A minimum of 100 of those 300 hours must occur during the capstone experience and include direct provision of authentic interpreting experiences supervised by interpreters who hold national certification that is psychometrically reliable and valid: certifications, credentials, and qualifications of the onsite supervising interpreter(s),</p>																		

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<p>criteria for selection of deaf supervisors and deaf supervised interpreting settings, and the number of total clock hours engaged in supervised interpreting).</p>																		
<p>8.3 Relationships between the program (and/or the institution of higher education) and the field experience sites are clearly defined and documented: letters, emails forms or documentation that ensures both entities are aware of student placement, how sites are screened and selected, criteria used, and how the sites are evaluated to ensure consistency.</p>																		
<p>8.4 Roles and responsibilities of the faculty coordinator, students, and onsite supervisors/mentors are clearly defined and documented: copies of the samples of agreement forms; samples of forms that articulate goals, samples of forms that delineate the roles and responsibilities of the student, site, onsite supervisor, and program, and a description of the mechanism by which the program and the site maintain contact throughout the interpreting field experience.</p>
